

BEST CAESAR COMPETITION Rules and Regulations

The **Best Caesar Competition** is getting a great response from guests and the Judging panel is eager to dive into your tasty concoctions and crown a champion. This is a great Canadian icon and a perfect platform to introduce creativity and skill.

General Rules

- Medley Food & Drink Festival **Best Caesar Competition** is a live event beverage competition where competitors have forty (40) minutes to create their product entries for submission in the competition.
- Each competitor will need be provided a Napoleon grill and a work station to create Six (6) completed Caesar Cocktails.
- Competitors may have one (1) assistant during the competition period.
- A maximum of five (5) participants will compete in the competition.
- Competition start time is 2:00 PM EST on Sunday, July 22 in the "Napoleon Pavilion" at Southshore Park in Barrie, ON

Competitor Turn-In

- All competition entries must be prepared onsite during the competition period, no entries previously prepared will be
 accepted with the exception of prepackaged material/products. (Contact event organizer if further clarity is required).
- The competitors Caesar Cocktail product must contain vodka, cayenne or chilli pepper component, black pepper and a clam based ingredient in the beverage element of the cocktail and must also feature a "rimmer" element on the vessel.
- Turn-in to the judges can be served within any vessel of the competitors choosing and supplied by the competitor or a standard glass will be provided.
- Creativity is encourage, however cocktails must be reasonably identifiable as a Caesar Cocktail. Proceed knowingly.
- Servings
 - Competitors will create six (6) complete cocktails (one will be for event production purposes).
- Presentation décor/garnish is up to the competitor.
- A late turn-in will receive a deduction of 1 (one) point for each minute it is late.

Judging Process

- The Best Caesar Cocktail Competition is not a blind judging.
- The contestant(s) are required to be on the stage/at the venue at the time of the judging to provide a description of their entry to the Judging panel.
- Judges will be instructed to judge each entry with the lowest score being zero based on:

Execution 0-5 Points
 Creativity 0-5 Points
 Presentation 0-5 Points
 Canadiana 0-5 Points
 Taste 0-10 Points
 Total 30 Points

- Judges will be instructed to not converse or discuss the entries until all judges have completed scoring and the score cards have been collected.
- Each entry will be judged on its own individual merits as opposed to comparatively against the other entries.
- The weighted totals from each judge will be collected and added together to make a total score for each contestant.
- The contestant with the highest score wins the title of 2018 Medley Best Caesar Cocktail Champion.

Other Guidelines

- Appropriate sanitary equipment will be provided per regulations determined by local health and fire codes.
- Competitors are required to provide appropriate ice and coolers for ingredients that must be maintained at a specific health department required temperature.
- Any violation of health or fire department regulations may result in the immediate disqualification of a competitor.
 Competitors may use Gas/Propane grills to compete.
